Transportation

Metro, Yellow taxi services and the Uber app are the most convenient form of transportation around Atlanta.

MARTA (Atlanta Metro system):

The Airport MARTA Station is directly connected to the Hartsfield-Jackson Airport Domestic Terminal at the end of baggage claim. The Red/gold trains (North –South) leave from the airport station about every 5 minutes, and will take about 20 minutes to get to Peach Tree Center Station. For the Georgia State Station it will take about 30 minute because you switch trains at Five Points to the Blue/Green (East-West).

Georgia State: The 2 closest stations are about equidistant from Centennial Hall, 100 Auburn Avenue (about ½ mile walking) – the Georgia State Station on the East/West line and the Peachtree Center station on the North/South line.

Academy of Medicine: The Peachtree Center station on the North/South line is two blocks away from the Academy of Medicine.
