Easterwood Airport (CLL) is just minutes from downtown College Station and approximately 4 miles from the Texas A&M Campus. United Airlines has flights daily to and from George Bush Intercontinental Airport. American Airlines has flights daily to and from Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport.

George Bush Intercontinental (IAH) - Houston, TX – 100 miles from Bryan College Station, Bush Intercontinental is the largest hub for United Airlines and serves more than 40 million passengers annually.

Houston Hobby (HOU) - Just over 100 miles from Bryan College Station, Hobby provides non-stop flights to over 40 destinations throughout the US.
