The UIDP has sent this message to the individual identified as the primary contact to the partnership. This individual (or any other designated representative) may complete the enclosed ballot. Only one person from the member organization may vote.

The University-Industry Demonstration Partnership 2016 election contest is for three seats; one (1) Industry Director, one (1) University Director, and the Incoming Chair from the university category. Terms for the Director seats will be two years, and the term for the Incoming Chair seat will be one year, followed by another year as UIDP Presiding Chair, and a subsequent year as Immediate Past Chair. All terms begin on **July 1, 2016**. Voting will begin on **Monday, May 16, 2016**, and ends **Friday, May 27, 2016**; the results will be announced on **June 1, 2016**.
