

The Federal Budget in FY 2022



The Federal Budget Process

SPRING

Federal agencies begin work on FY 25 budgets

AUG - NOV

Agencies submit budgets to OMB. OMB makes decisions on agency budget.

DEC - JAN

OMB Finalizes
Budget.
Agencies can
appeal directly to
the President.

FEB

President submits budget to Congress.

MARCH

House and Senate Appropriations Committee start hearings and begin work on Budget Resolution, establishing the 302A allocation.

APRIL

Appropriations
Committees make
allocations to the 12
subcommittees.

SUMMER

12 subcommittees draft their respective appropriations bills.

AUG - OCT

OMB formulates Anomalies Package. Oct. 1 starts the new fiscal year; CR is passed or government shuts down nonessential activities.

NOV - DEC

Congress and Administration come to an agreement and Congress passes final bills.
