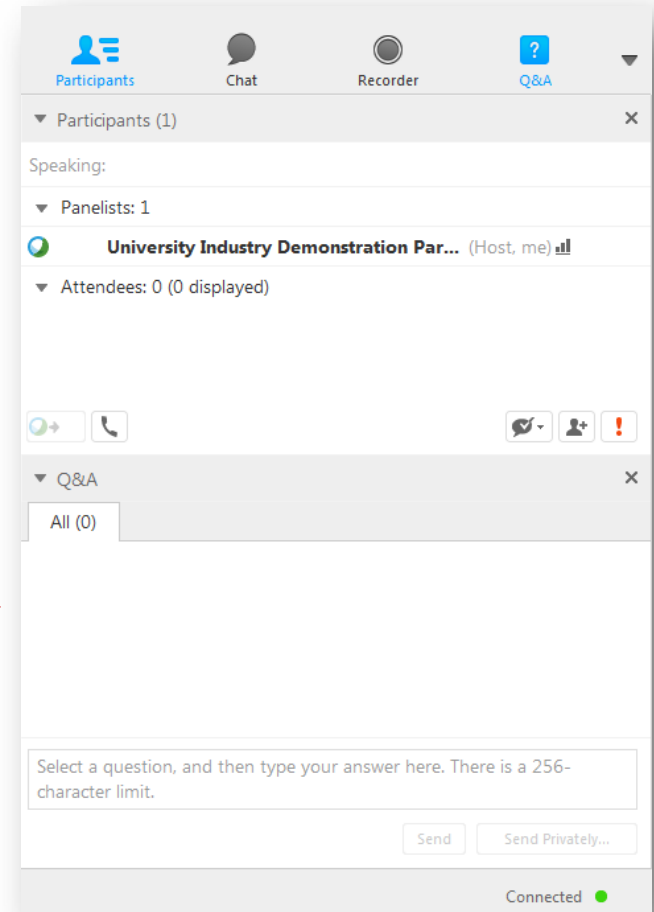

# Overview – *key things to cover include*

# What – Center Summary and Objectives (1-2 slides)

- High level discussion of the Center with focus on unique features and skills
- Can optionally build in a few of key players if helps with narrative
- Give timeline for initiation, renewal and other key dates
- Provide URL to more detailed information



# Locations (1 slide)

- Key locations and focus/capabilities at locations
- Optionally list 'other locations' if appropriate for areas with lower levels of activity

# Key Participants (1-2 slides)

- Academic – by institution
- Industry – list companies and sectors (if not obvious)
- Other - govt labs, local groups/incubators etc

# Leadership (1 slide)

- Key administrative roles and and academic 'thought leaders'
- Key governance / advisory board members and affiliations

# Program Summary (1-4 slides)

- Slide 1 –high – level programmatic focus areas
- Slide 2 -4 additional detail with optional slides on representative programs
- Can include final slide with a few key findings/results if appropriate

# Governance (1-2 slides)

- How projects are selected
- How ongoing projects are managed and communicated
- Other key processes (if different from normal IUCRC processes); e.g. patents, publications, termination of projects
- Meeting frequency and date of next meeting(s)
- Membership levels

# How to Get Involved (1 slide)

- Membership requirements, levels and dues/fees structure
- Meeting frequency and date of next meeting(s) – Do you allow/encourage non-members to attend one meeting as observer? If so is an NDA required ?
- Any other options for participation?  
(sponsored research by non-members, in-kind contributions, research collaborations etc...)
